Why we need you?

ACT are the only fundraising charity that are dedicated to supporting the Addenbrooke's and Rosie Hospitals. We need your help to raise awareness of ACT in your community, so that more people know they can support Addenbrooke's by donating, fundraising or volunteering.

What will you do?

Our Fundraising Volunteers are the friendly face of ACT in their communities. They help to build new relationships within their local areas, encourage fundraising activities and raise awareness of how people can help us continue to make Addenbrooke's even better.

Volunteer activities can include:

- Giving talks to community groups or companies via online platforms and attending virtual cheque presentations.
- Sharing ACT messaging via social media.

- Forming a local fundraising group.
- Supporting the Community Fundraising Team with thanking events.

What time can you give?

- You will be provided with resources and training by our Community Fundraising Team to support you in this role.
- You will join a growing, friendly volunteer team that has an active programme of social events and a supportive supervision structure.
